**Subject:** Update on GHIN and AZGOLF website

To All our Men and Women golfers who maintain their GHIN at AZ National GC

--For the 2024 golfing year, AZ National will once again renew the GHIN online. You will receive SPECIFIC instructions around October 4 via email as in the past.

--A few changes have taken place on the AGA website. The member "Dashboard" will no longer be present. The website will feature several enhancements and dynamic elements to bring life and fun to the screen.

--Score posting can still be accessed from the AZGOLF website; however, the "POST A SCORE" button will take you to [GHIN.COM](https://ghin.com) to post your score where you will also have access to your stats, complete score history, handicap calculator, and handicap card.

--Remember, you must have a GHIN DIGITAL PROFILE to post scores on GHIN.com and through the USGA GHIN Mobile App. If you have not used GHIN.com or the GHIN Mobile App, you will need to use the "CREATE PROFILE" button to create your digital profile. It is easy to do and just takes a few minutes.

--Lastly, please WAIT till you receive the email in October to renew your dues. Dues will be \$40, a discount of \$5 since we use the join/renew online. If you belong to several clubs in AZ, you will pay a multi-member rate of \$15 after the first GHIN fee of \$40.

--Reminder, if you make an error on your score or posting on the incorrect tees, please text Barb Klink, (520-907-4288) or email her at [BJKLI@comcast.net](mailto:BJKLI@comcast.net) so she can make the corrections for you. If you post a score today, September 1, she will be able to make the change for you on September 2. She will respond back to you that the change has been made.
