

## Eclectic (Ringer) Game Rules and Guidelines

The principle of an eclectic competition is brilliant: for every round you play; only the best score on each and every hole is kept. You end up with one eclectic sheet showing your best score for each hole you played within the specified period. See the attached example sheet.

Spring 2023 Eclectic game will run from Mar 16 through June 15, entry fee is \$5.00.

### Quick sign-up Rules:

1. Print the attached Eclectic Sheet (not the example sheet) Enter your **LAST NAME, FIRST NAME** on the top of the sheet. There will be some blank forms in the front of the black folder and on the website.
2. Attach \$5.00 to your sheet (or drop an envelope in the mail box with your name on it) and file it under your last name.
3. Place it in the Black Folder in the ladies locker room.
  - a. First round will be your complete Hole-by-Hole scored round.
  - b. Subsequently, enter the date and only the holes where your score improved (see example sheet attached which makes it easier to understand the game)
  - c. Attach your attested score card, by a league member (not just Thursdays) each date that you have an improved score on a hole. I will verify that you didn't miss a good score once a week and then discard the score card.

...And the rest of the boring, but necessary rules.

Eclectic scores may be posted on any day when playing with a Women's Division member and attested to by the member.

Scores may not be claimed for holes that are altered for special party competition.

Holes finished out (no gimmies) in a round are eligible for entry even if some other holes are maxed out or picked up. Picking up on a hole does not disqualify the round.

Awards for Eclectic games: TBD - Eclectic Game, prizes will be determined based on the number of participants. We are thinking of Gross and net placements, and perhaps by back and front, and maybe a special surprise!

We will decide based on the number of participants, we don't want to spread the winnings too thin. No one can win more than one category,

Handicaps in effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> or 15<sup>th</sup> closest to the end date will be used to determine the Eclectic Game winners.
