

Code of Conduct

(approved April 2025)

Any of the following actions by members of AHWGA during any AHWGA affiliated event constitutes a violation of the Code of Conduct. Any member who fails to comply with the Code of Conduct, at the board's discretion, will be subject to disciplinary action laid out in the AHWGA Standing Rules.

- Verbal abuse, physical abuse, or legitimate threats of abuse toward fellow players, competitors, guests, or golf course staff
- Intentional club throwing or behavior that could result in the damage of any player's equipment or the golf course.
- Failure to show consideration for others (For example, habitually not playing at a proper pace, intentionally distracting the play of another player, not playing by the USGA and established local rules, no-shows, etc.)
- Consuming alcoholic beverages in an irresponsible manner which results in impairment or obvious intoxication
