Player A's ball is in the fairway. As Player A walks toward the ball, a dog runs across the fairway and moves her ball a few feet from its original spot. Player A drops the ball within one club-length of the estimated spot where the original ball had come to rest. Player A plays the ball.

> A: One-Stroke Penalty B: Two-Stroke Penalty C: No Penalty

Rules Trivia Answer

B: Two-Stroke Penalty

Player A's ball was moved by an outside influence. The ball must be replaced on its original spot, which if not known must be estimated. See Rule 9.6 and the Definition of "Replace."

When Player A dropped the ball in a one club-length area, it is unlikely that the ball was played from the original spot and Player A gets a two-stroke penalty for playing from a wrong place. See Rule 14.7a and Interpretation 14.2b(2)/1.
