



Rules Trivia

Test your Rules of Golf knowledge with this trivia question:

What is the Penalty, if any?

In stroke play, Player A's tee shot comes to rest with part of the ball in the general area and about two-thirds of the ball on a white line defining out of bounds.


Believing the ball to be on the course, Player A takes a stance and determines that an irrigation control box that is out of bounds interferes with Player A's area of intended swing. Player A determines the nearest point of complete relief from the irrigation control box and the relief area; drops a ball in the relief area, plays the ball onto the putting green, and completes the hole.

A: One-Stroke Penalty

B: Two-Stroke Penalty

C: No Penalty

B: Two Stroke Penalty

In this case, Player A's ball was in bounds. [Rule 18.2a(2)]

The irrigation control box is not considered on the course, therefore there is no relief without penalty for an obstruction that is not on the course. [Rule 16.1a(2)]

Player A lifted the ball without authority and played from the wrong place, getting the general penalty of two strokes for a breach of Rule 9.4b and Rule 14.7a.

Lifting the ball without authority and playing from the wrong place are related acts.

See Rule 1.3c(4) and the Clarification, Added 12/2018 to Rule 1.3c(4).
