

# We Are The Champions

December 4 proved to be a very good day for the members of the Del Lago Men's Golf Club as Stuart Katz and Chas Giufurta and Bob Snodgrass and Steve Fitzgerald won their respective divisions at the 26<sup>th</sup> Club Team Championships held under the auspices of the Arizona Golf Association. The Verrado Founders Course in Buckeye was the site of the event.

Katz and Giufurta carded a Low Net 64.69 to take the honors in the Super Seniors Division (both team members must be over 70 years of age) while Snodgrass and Fitzgerald shot a 66.64 for the Low Net championship in the Sarazen Division. Al Helms and Bill McCall took third in the Super Seniors while Jim Shak and Steve Robinson fired a 74 for 6<sup>th</sup> place in the Low Gross section of the Nelson Flight. The father son team of Brian and Jaxon Pearson were 5<sup>th</sup> in the 11 team field of the Jones flight with a 67 gross score.

On the 3<sup>rd</sup> of December, in Green Valley, John Blumenshine defended his Super Seniors title in the San Ignacio Open with a two-day total of 148 to win the Low Gross competition and Jeff McCall finished 5<sup>th</sup> in the Open Division.

"It was a very successful couple of days for the members of the Men's Club," stated Snodgrass. "As President, I'm a very proud of all our members who compete in any of the events held locally or statewide throughout the year regardless of where they finish, but winning is always sweeter." Katz commented, "Chas and I putted well. I believe we had 29 putts n 18 holes. We had five birdies and one bogey during the round."
