CENTRAL ARIZONA GOLF DISTRICT (CAGD) – Motto is Meet. Greet. Compete.

The Central Arizona Golf District is an all-volunteer, non-profit organization founded in 1961 that offers women, of all skill levels, a chance to compete and have fun golfing. There are more than 1,300 members from all corners of the Greater Phoenix and central Arizona counties. If you have an official GHIN handicap, and are a member of a sanctioned women's league associated with the Arizona Golf Association, you are welcome to join. The CAGD (Central District) conducts an inter club Blind Draw, hosts 5-member tournaments a year and supports local charities that promote youth golf.

CRWGA members have the option to pay \$13 to join the Central District when they register for the League. The \$13 includes the \$8 CAGD dues and \$1 (\$5 total) for each Blind Draw play day. The \$8 yearly dues entitle the player to enter any of the CAGD tournaments during the year.

The Intra-District Blind Draw tournaments provide competition and prize money between member clubs of the Central District five times a year. These play days are played at Coyote Run along with the regular play of the day competition. The CAGD Representative calculates and sends the individual results to CAGD Blind Draw Chair for payout calculation and announces and posts the winners for that month. The winnings for the individual players are credited to their Sweeps by the Pro Shop.
