This guideline should help you become familiar with our club and get you started on a great season of golf.

PV Ladies Locker Room

- Located inside to the left in the Women's Restroom at the PV Clubhouse
- Bulletin boards used to post information on upcoming and special events, results for Ringers, CAGD. Etc.
- Locked drawer with a slot where checks for special events can be deposited.

PVLGA DUES:

- Dues are \$80.00, due on December 1.
- Dues are paid online. Information will be provided when the annual dues must be paid.
- Dues are allocated to the AWGA for our handicaps, payouts (in the form of chits) for Tuesday play, and to cover miscellaneous expenses such as office supplies, awards, etc.
- A late fee is charged if renewal is after December 1.

Chelsea System

- Used for making tee times.
- Used to sign up for Tuesday Ladies Day games
- The Chelsea System is available through your computer and the computer in the Pro Shop.
- Annual golf membership will be given priority in Chelsea for tee times.
- You will receive an e-mail a couple of days before your requested play date advising you of your tee time, the hole you will be starting on and the names of the group you will play with.
- The Pros can assist you if you do not know how to log into Chelsea.

Recording Scores

- You can post your scores online at <u>WWW.AZGOLF.ORG</u> at home or on the computer in the Pro Shop.
- You will need the AWGA GHIN number that was given that was provided to you when you paid your dues.
- The posting of scores is monitored to assure that our handicaps reflect all our scores.
- REMEMBER, ALL GAMES MUST BE POSTED, REGARDLESS OF WHAT COURSE YOU HAVE PLAYED!

Special Events: Tournaments:

- A signup sheet will be posted in the Ladies Lounge for special events such as the Cotton/Verde, The Member/Guest and the PICO Crossover.
- DO NOT sign up with Chelsea for these events.
- Signup sheets are put up one month prior to the event and taken down Friday at noon

- Some events require an entry fee. In those cases, you must pay a fee when you sign up. PAYMENT IS BY CHECK ONLY- DO NOT PAY IN CASH.
- Make checks payable to PVLGA and reference the name of the event on the memo line.
- There is a locked drawer with a slot in the Ladies Lounge please put your check in that slot.
- Checks written in pencil will not be accepted.
- The President's Cup and the Club Championship events DO NOT require an entry fee.
 - You need only to sign up and the Handicap Chairwoman will check all names for eligibility.

Regular Tuesday Ladies Day:

- Sign up through Chelsea.
- You can sign up 7 days in advance.
- CANCELLATIONS MUST BE MADE WITH THE PRO SHOP before noon on the Monday prior to the shotgun start.
- The designated Captain of each foursome will keep the official score, settle disputes and assist new members with the rules.
- The Pro Shop will post postable scores on Tuesday Ladies Day.

Luncheon/Business Meetings:

- These meetings are held on Tuesday Ladies Day in January, March, May, October and December.
- The signup sheet will be in the Ladies Lounge.
- Please note: these are a 'package' deal you must pay for the luncheon that day if you want to play.
- You may sign up for lunch onlyl.
