*Chelsea Update for 2021: **Host Members**: with Guests will be assigned 2 Guest points, for each guest they have in their group; this is done to protect the tee sheet for all our golfers; SaddleBrooke Guests must Not live in HOA 1 or 2.

Tee time draw process

- -The daily tee time draw will be made 5 days in advance of the date of play by the Chelsea system prior to the opening of the golf shop. The system will attempt to create foursomes by combining singles, twosomes and threesomes accordingly before the draw is made.
- -Tee time requests are ranked from the group with the least number of average points to the group with the highest average of number of points. The group with the least number of average points is given first priority by the computer system in determining tee time placement.
- -The Chelsea system looks at "lowest average number of points" for both foursomes and threesomes. Twosomes and singles will be paired up to maximize the tee sheets; <u>Singles</u> Do not make requests online in Chelsea, call golf shop.

Tee Time Point Accumulation

Chelsea Points are determined by the date that the draw is conducted on. Players' points are calculated 8 days prior to the date of draw and 4 days forward from said date of draw. Bookings beyond 5 days will not affect a player's point total.

Point Deductions

If a player receives a tee time more than 1 hour from their requested tee time, 0.1 Placement Points will be deducted up to the maximum of 0.5 points for each hour that the actual tee time differs from the tee time requested.

Linked Groups

Groups of more than 6 players may "link" their requested tee times together in order to keep the group together. Linked groups points are determined by calculating the average number of points for all players. This number of points is then assigned to each of the groups in the link prior to the tee time draw in order to establish priority.

Walk-On Play and No Shows

Walk on players are those without a tee time and are willing to play at any Open spot. Walk on players will not receive placement points for the day but will receive Play Points for that day.

No Shows: Any player who fails to show for a scheduled tee time and does not notify the golf shop shall receive 4 NO SHOW Points, PLUS their Placement Points for that day.

Each player will receive points for receiving a tee time according to their golf membership status. Points are also assigned to each player for playing on the date of play.
